Site Operator – Full time Position

Denison Environmental Services (DES), a division of Denison Mines Inc., (Yukon COR certified and Elliot Lake ISO 9001:2008 registered) is a nationally recognized leader in the supply of mine care and maintenance (C&M), mine-site decommissioning and consulting services across Canada. DES is currently seeking a full time Site Operator for the Mt. Nansen Project, YT (60 km West of Carmacks). This position would suit an individual with an aptitude for troubleshooting, maintenance and repairs of generators, electrical equipment, and communications systems.

Denison offers an attractive compensation and benefits package, which includes health and dental coverage, life insurance, a retirement savings arrangement and bonus plan.

Your work schedule will be based on working 10 hours per day on a rotation of two weeks in, two weeks out. Transportation will be provided to and from Carmacks during shift change. DES provides a \$30.00/day meal allowance (paid by separate cheque) as employees at Mount Nansen are responsible to supply and cook their own food. The Mount Nansen Project is a dry camp meaning no alcohol or illicit drugs are permitted on site.

General responsibilities include:

- Operation and maintenance of electrical generation and transmission equipment
- Operation and maintenance of fuel and water distribution systems
- Operation and maintenance of buildings, and mobile and stationary equipment
- Operation and maintenance of pumping and communications systems
- Maintenance of roads and diversion ditches
- Site security, safety, and first aid
- Housekeeping and site cleanup
- Maintenance of pipefitting
- General site inspections and monitoring
- Conformance with Health and Safety Program
- Conformance with Denison Mines Corp (DMC) policies

The ideal candidate will have the following qualifications:

- Valid Standard First Aid/CPR Certificate, (advanced First Aid Certificate an asset)
- Valid Yukon Driver's License
- Up to 5 years' experience in operation and maintenance of both mobile and stationary equipment
- Safely operate and maintain both mobile (rubber tired backhoe, excavator, dozer) and stationary (pumps, generators) equipment
- Willingness and ability to participate in varied work activities (both operations and labour related)
- Physically able to perform the functions of the position
