Millwright (Industrial Mechanic) – Full time Position

This position would suit an experienced mechanic with a minimum of 10 years experience in a mine effluent treatment plant, mine, mill or similar operations. The successful candidate will be responsible for all aspects of maintenance and repairs of an effluent treatment plant equipment and associated pump station equipment. This equipment consists of: vertical turbine, horizontal centrifugal and submersible pumps; mechanical agitators; lime slaking equipment; manual and automated valves; and others equipment.

The regular work week for this position is four (4) days of ten (10) hours per day for the week. There will also be a daily travel allowance from Villebois to the Selbaie site.

General responsibilities include:

- Participation in the comprehensive Health, Safety, Environment and Community (HSEC) program;
- Implementation of the preventative maintenance program and support planning;
- Completion of emergency repairs;
- Providing support to the Superintendent of DES operations and other staff for the preventive maintenance program, procurement of parts and supplies and other related jobs to keep the site operating safely and in compliance.
