Denison Environmental Services (DES), a division of Denison Mines Inc. (Yukon COR certified and Elliot Lake ISO 9001:2008 registered), is a leader in mine decommissioning and care and maintenance services for closed mine sites in Canada. On April 20, 2012, DES began care and maintenance operations at the Mount Nansen Mine Site under contract to Yukon Government Assessment and Abandoned Mine Branch (YG).

DES is seeking a part time Summer Student (up to 70 hours, every other week) to join our team at the site.

Reporting to the Site Manager, the role of the Summer Student involves:

- Assisting the Site staff in daily operation and maintenance activities,
- Daily inspection rounds to monitor the condition of site infrastructure,
- Documenting operational checks and maintenance records on daily report forms,
- Following established safety procedures and operation manuals,
- Performing preventative maintenance on site equipment,
- General housekeeping in the bunkhouse, kitchen and shop,
- General site cleanup activities,
- Other duties as may be assigned by the Site Manager.

DES will tailor a development program based on the interest of the applicant. The term of this position is currently anticipated to be part time for approximately 2-months (June to mid August). The Summer Student will be required to work 10 hour day shifts on a 1-week on, 1-week off shift rotation. This position will involve manual labour indoors and outdoors (climbing ladders, shoveling, lifting heavy objects, mechanical maintenance).

Transportation will be provided to and from Carmacks during shift change. All DES employees at Mount Nansen supply and cook their own food. A meal allowance is provided by DES to off-set the costs of food.

QUALIFICATIONS and REQUIREMENTS

- Full-time student intending to return to their studies in the next school year (CSJ funding requirement)
- Valid Yukon Driver's License,
- Valid Standard First Aid/CPR Certificate, (Note that training may be available for the successful candidate who may not have a current valid certificate),
- aged 15 – 30 years (CSJ funding requirement)
- physically able to perform the functions of the position., and
- Ability to read, understand and follow standard operating procedures and safety requirements.
